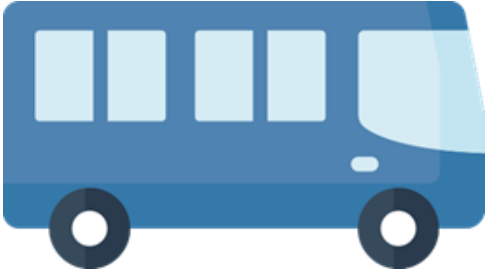

Addressing Rural Transportation Challenges

Event Speaker:

Robin Phillips is the executive director at the National Rural Transit Assistance Program (RTAP). Her BA in history and JD in law enables Robin to shape rural transit assistance through the foundation of law. She worked for the Oregon Department of Transportation (DOT), where she was hired to write and implement a multi-modal intercity policy that resulted in the Oregon Intercity Network. This collaboration between the 5311 program and the rail program shifted the paradigm from community projects to regional connectivity and access to transportation networks. As information about services is as important as the services themselves, Robin previously worked at the Washington State DOT on finding ways to help rural providers input their data to increase awareness and access to services. Finding the right balance of public and private investment has been integral to Robin's career. In 2007, Robin was the senior policy director at the American Bus Association, where she facilitated collaborations between private operators and state and federal programs. Robin is dedicated to improving transportation in rural communities.
